



Curriculum Map: Term One

Key Stage Two

English

We are going to be looking at Non-Fiction texts including information books, newspapers and magazines. Pupils will be identifying the different features of a book, looking at how to identify and locate different information. Pupils will also be identifying the purpose of newspapers and be creating their own newspaper article!

RE

Our Unit focus for this term is 'How and why should we care for our world?'. Pupils will be identifying the people that are responsible for looking after our world and why looking after our world is important. We are also going to be looking at the Creation Story.

Art/DT

In DT we are going to be learning about shelters. Pupils are going to look at what they are, what they are used for and why they are needed. Pupils are also going to design and construct their own model shelter and think about who will use the shelter, what will be its purpose and what materials they are going to need!

Maths

Place Value and Fractions- We are going to be looking at the place value of each digit in a number up to 4 digits, counting forwards and backwards in multiples from a given number, understanding how numbers are represented in Roman Numerals, identifying what a unit fraction is and comparing, counting and ordering fractions with the same denominator.

Music

Our unit focus for this term is 'Recycled Music'. Pupils are going to investigate, through different experiments, how sound is produced, identify how everyday objects can be turned into instruments and create their instrument using recycled materials!

Geography

Our first topic in geography is going to be 'The UK'. Pupils are going to be naming and locating the countries, cities and rivers of the UK. Pupils are also going to be looking at the different counties within the UK and use a map and compass rose to locate these. Towards the end of our unit, pupils are going to be identifying and evaluating how the UK has changed over time.

Science

Our topic for this term is 'Plants and Animals in the local environment'. Pupils are going to be exploring places in which animals and plants may live, learn how to treat animals and plants sensitively and understand what humans, animals and plants need to live well.

PSHE

In PSHE this term pupils are going to be looking at their own personal values and be identifying what makes them amazing individuals. Throughout the unit, pupils will also be identifying their own unique strengths and talents.

Computing

In computing this term, we are going to be looking at 'Our Local Area'. Pupils are going to look at websites linking to our local area and explore lots of online maps. Pupils are also going to look at creating their own map of the local area and have fun using a programmable toy to explore their different maps.
