## Rewards:

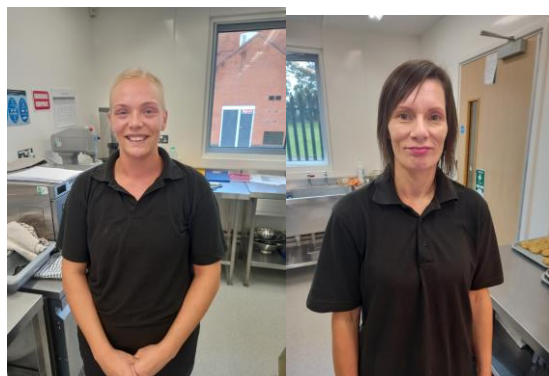
Class of the week is Rowling! Please keep an eye on our website for award photos. Most star points award is Dahl class. They will be getting a full breakfast on the first Monday back!
