English

Students will be looking at both poetry and non-fiction in this unit, exploring how different animals migrate and comparing narrative poems. They will understand how to skim and scan read, integrate dialogue within poetry and use relative clauses to present information clearly.

Maths

In this unit, the children will be learning different techniques and methods to support with their learning of multiplication and division, along with different aspects of Maths that will support such as area.

Art and DT – Design Technology

The children will be learning to compare and delve into installation art, creating their own pieces along the way.

History

Pupils will be looking at the Tudors and exploring what kind of ruler each Tudor monarch was for England.

Computing

The pupils will be exploring the use of video, learning how to produce, edit and frame different types of camera shots, resulting in their own final video towards the end of the term.

Music

In this unit, pupils will be looking at the history of Blues music and how this has influenced a more modern day sound.

Science

The children will be investigating into the life cycle of a plant, looking at how plants reproduce, seed dispersal and germination. The children will apply this knowledge to animals and understand conservation and growing rates of extio

RSE

Students will be looking into the way their bodies function and change throughout puberty, they will learn about the menstrual cycle and understand the effect that can have on fertility.

PSHE

The pupils will be looking into different health risks such as eating disorders, drug use and the effects of smoking and vaping.

French

In this unit the students are looking into how to describe clothing and outfits using the correct French sentence structure and feminine and masculine prefixes.

RE

In this unit the pupils will explore different Biblical texts, looking into how Christianity views Jesus as the Messigh and a saviour from God.
