

English – Celebrations

Pupils will explore a range of celebrations including Halloween, Diwali, Bonfire Night, Thanksgiving and Christmas. Pupils will focus on a new book each week including books such as Funny bones, Thankful, A Magical Muddle and The Jolly Christmas Postman. Pupils will complete a range of book related activities including, writing character, and setting descriptions, letters, diary entries and labelling pictures.

Maths – Place Value and Addition

Pupils will sort objects into groups and count objects to 10. Pupils will recognise numbers as words and find one more and one less. Pupils will compare groups by matching and use less than, greater than and equal to within 10. Pupils will be introduced to part-whole models, write number sentences, and find number bonds to 10.

Art and DT

Geography – What is it like here?

Pupils will locate the school on an aerial photograph and create a simple map of our classroom. Pupils will go outside to locate the key features of the playground and investigate how we feel about our playground. Pupils will create a map of the playground and then create a design to improve it.

Computing – Technology

Pupils will identify technology and identify a computer and its main parts. Pupils will use a mouse in different ways and use a keyboard to type on a computer. Pupils will then move on to using the keyboard to edit the text they have written and create rules for using technology responsibly.

PE – Running and Jumping

Pupils will develop basic techniques for jumping, running skills and balance while running. Pupils will develop short distance running and jumping techniques.

Science – Ourselves

Pupils will understand that humans have bodies with special parts. Pupils will explore the 5 senses and discover that all animals, including humans, grow and change as they become older. Pupils will make observations and comparisons of height and will recognise that there are differences between humans. Pupils will understand that we need to eat and drink to stay alive.
