Fiction – In this unit pupils will be planning and writing setting descriptions to create mood based on the class text. Pupils will be able to answer questions and make predictions about the text. In Poetry pupils will be learning about calligrams before writing their own. Pupils will also develop their persuasive writing and questioning techniques when debating.

Maths

Multiplication and Division - In this unit pupils will develop their multiplication and division skills. Pupils will use grouping, sharing and arrays to help them understand and apply the 3,4 and 8-times tables. They will also learn strategies to efficiently multiply and divide numbers by 3,4 and 8.

Art and DT – Art – Drawing.

In Art, we will be developing our observational drawing skills by finding the shapes we can use to draw more complex objects. We will practice shading and use of proportion to complete our own abstract art.

Pupils will be developing their own compositions to perform. Taking inspiration from the Chinese New Year pupils will make their own pentatonic melodies.

RSE – Pupils will look at how the body changes from childhood into adult hood. Pupils will learn about the stages of puberty. Pupils will gain an understanding of how everybody is different. Pupils will recap the PANTS Rule and know how to look after their bodies and keep themselves safe.

PSHE – Pupils will look at safety in the community. Pupils will think about their special places and what is important to them. They will explore what privacy is and how it is important. Pupils will also look at how to keep themselves safe when out in the community including when at the park, near water and railways.

Computing

Pupils will be looking at stop-frame animations. Pupils will plan and predict what an animation will look like. Pupils will then make their own animation considering scenery, characters and story.

History – Pupils will be answering the question: 'Would you prefer to live in the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age?'. We will look at life in prehistoric times and make comparisons. Pupils will discover how advancements in technology changed peoples way of life and the importance of trading.

French – Pupils will Learn the words for different colours, shapes and sizes. They will use the vocabulary they learn to describe and produce their own artwork inspired by the artist Matisse.

PE –

Pupils will be developing their football skills. We will practice passing and receive the ball. Pupils will learn skills for defending and tackling during a game.

Science – Pupils will investigate what plants need to grow well. We will find out about the things that plants need to grow well and use our scientific skill to plan and carry out an investigation. Pupils will also gain an understanding on how plants grow.

RE- In RE pupils will answer the question: 'What does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today?'. We will explore how Hindu's celebrate with their families and communities. Pupils will also learn about different Hindu festivals and the meaning behind them.
