Non-Fiction – In this unit, pupils will explore the Big Question: 'Which animal makes the toughest migration?' Pupils will read the interactive eBook, using the skills of skimming and scanning to find answers to questions and using the organisational features of the eBook to find information. Pupils will then plan and write a chronological report about a specific animal migration of their choice.

Maths – In this unit, students will build on their knowledge of multiplication and division. Students will be able to use long multiplication up to four digits by two-digit numbers and be introduced to short division.

Art and DT – Sculptures & 3D – Interactive installations. In this unit, pupils will identify and compare features of art installations. Pupils will explore how everyday 3D objects can create installation art. Pupils will then apply their knowledge of installation art to develop and evaluate their own installation art work to meet the criteria.

History – In this unit, students will explore what life was like in Tudor England. Pupils will use primary and secondary sources to make deductions and investigate about Henry VIII's wives. Pupils will then create a realistic inventory for a person living in Tudor times.

Music – Students will identify key features of 'Blues music' and develop an understanding of the history of this music. Pupils will be able to use and understand staff and other musical notations. Pupils will then have a go at improvising some music using the Blues scale.

RSE – In this unit, students will explore what puberty is and how this can affect this can have on your body. Pupils will be introduced to correct terms of different body parts and be able to identify that everyone develops at different rates.

PSHE – In this unit, pupils will look at healthy lifestyles and understand how to make healthy diet choices. Pupils will learn about different exercise and relaxation and explore the benefits this can have on their mental and physical health.

Computing – In this unit students identify features of visual media. Pupils will capture video using a range of filming techniques and experiment with different camera angles to produce and edit their own video.

French – Pupils will be able to describe items of clothing and use appropriate determiners. Pupils will then be able to identify adjectival position in a sentence and describe their likes and dislikes with outfits.

PE – In this unit, students will be able to replicate a jump shot used in handball. Pupils will then be able to perform a pivot to create space to pass or shoot and practice how to goal keep.

Science – Life Cycles
In this unit, students will look at the life cycle of flowering plants and how these are reproduced. Students will then be able to identify how seeds can be dispersed in different ways. Students will then look at the growth and development of humans and discuss different stages of the life cycle.
