Engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity	 Physical Education (PE) and Enrichment as part of every pupil's timetable, coordinated/delivered by qualified teachers and an Outdoor Education Instructor. An activity will be organised for all play times to provide a sportsbased activity for pupils to participate in each day. Upper school pupils have an Enrichment session on a Thursday afternoon with organised activities for pupils to take part in which include sports activities. Foxfields works with local professional sports teams who come in to deliver specialist coaching e.g. Leicester Tigers – Rugby coaching. Leicester City FC premier League stars. Weekly swimming lessons with qualified instructors 	 Daily opportunities for pupils to be physically active. Enrichment provides an additional option for physical activity and significantly broadens the offer of activities alongside PE. Pupils develop communication and social interaction skills.
