English

Entry level 3- Pupils will focus on the skills needed for reading, including each section of the VIPERS. Pupils will also understand the features of narratives, write their own narratives and be able to verbally discuss and respond to questions.

BTEC Hospitality

In this unit, the children will be looking into how to prepare and cook food by baking, grilling and roasting. The pupils will explore different methods in the kitchen to support with this and will be able to follow a recipe using these skills independently.

Humanities

History this term has been based on World War 2, the leaders, women's roles, evacuees experiences, and the parts of the war that had a large impact on the result.

Computing

Pupils will use different software to meet needs of the task required. Pupils will also learn how to produce and adapt documents for different purposes.

PE – Pupils will focus on skills and moves to effectively play a successful game of Handball including pivots, dribbling and jump shots.

PSHE

Students will look at different jobs and how to apply for them They will look at C.V. writing as well as filling out job applications. Pupils will also look at how to open bank accounts.

Maths

Entry Level 2- Pupils will focus on using all four operations within 2 and 3-digit numbers, with exchanging. Pupils will also be introduced to estimation, times tables facts and multiplying and dividing by 10s, 100s and 1000s.

Entry Level 3- Pupils will focus on using all four operations with exchanging, including the use of increasingly larger numbers. Pupils will also be introduced to scaling problems alongside BIDMAS and recapping place value when multiplying and dividing by 10s, 100s and 1000s.

The students will be developing their own physicality through adventurous activity, progress individual skills such as campfire cooking and volunteering around school and in the community.

Animal Care

the students will look at safety around animals both in theory and in practical as well as learning and demonstrating safe handling techniques of a variety of animals such as a horse, goats and auinea pias

Physics

Pupils will learn about the different types of galaxies including our own. Pupils will also know factors which affect different planets and moons.

BTEC Sport

Students will learn about the reasons why people participate in sports, as well as the skills and techniques needed for a variety of team and individual sports. They will also have the opportunity to participate in sports activities and reflect on their participation over time.

Photography

The photography students have been learning how to use digital SLR cameras, critiquing photographs in their scrapbooks, and have had a field trip to Bradgate Park.

Chemistry

Pupils will understand different household products for their potential to harm environments, which products can be recycled and which are made from non-renewable sources.

Biology

Pupils will know the different major systems within the body including: the circulatory system, digestive system, nervous system and the factors affecting health.
