English

Poetry – Pop Poetry: The unit is primarily designed to enhance teenage appreciation of poetry by drawing parallels with pop music and analyzing elements of both with equal seriousness and frivolity.

Maths

Constructing in 2 and 3 dimensions and reasoning with number 3 dimensions would learn about the identification, classification, construction, and measurement of 2D and 3D shapes, as well as how to solve problems involving them using spatial reasoning and visualization skills.

Cooking -

Basic cooking skills and techniques, as well as how to explore the kitchen and experiment with different ingredients and flavours.

History – Norman Conquest

The Norman Conquest would cover the causes, events, and consequences of the 1066 invasion of England by William, Duke of Normandy, including its lasting impact on Enalish society and culture.

Computing

students will be editing with software and packages learning about their features, functions, and applications in digital content creation and collaboration.

Develop skills used within invasion games such as passing, control and attacking, effective defending with and without possession of the ball

Music

Orchestral instruments, time signatures, and theme development would help students learn about the different families of orchestral instruments, how to read and understand music notation.

Geography

Exploring the physical and human features of the world's major landforms would learn about their natural processes, characteristics, and human interactions.

Science

Metals and non-metals -learning about the properties, classification, and applications of these two groups of elements and their atomic make up.

RSE

"My body: Adolescence" would learn about the physical, emotional, and social changes of puberty and how to manage them.

PSHE

To help students develop the knowledge and skills they need to make informed decisions about their health and well-being, and to resist the pressure to use drugs, alcohol, tobacco, and other substances.

French

Studying sports vocabulary, grammar, comprehension, speaking, and writing using French sports would help students develop their French language, while also learning about French sports and culture.
